Highlights

 A learning excursion was organized to the Science City Ahmedabad for 57 children of the Halol center. This was an opportunity to nurture their creativity, spark curiosity, and inspire a lifelong love for science and technology

- Team AURA connected with the <u>Baroda Citizen's Council</u> to collaborate for two separate sessions. 60 children participated in a self awareness workshop, while 20 project managers experienced a seminar on Effective Heartful Communication

- **Power of resilience** was the topic for recent workshop that was conducted in February with a group of 15 youth
- Signed an MOU with the Faculty of Social Work, Parul University for deeper self-leadership work with the students
- In February Sambhav team along with Altaf and Jagruti met to discuss the next steps
- Group of 7 volunteers gather regularly to ideate and create spaces for the youth to connect, in the **Youth Adda project**



Outreach for more than 600 children


Ranu - Kanyashala (girls) Primary School; Kumarshala (boys) Primary School; Narsipura - Narsipura (co-ed) Primary School

What else is happening . . .


- **12 interns are** part of the internship experience at AURA. They are from Maharaja Sayajirao University and Parul University
